► Canada consistently has one of the highest per capita greenhouse gas emissions of the G20 countries. The construction of any new oil and gas extraction pipelines makes it impossible for Canada to meet any of its stated climate targets and commitments.

► As one of the world's wealthiest countries, with the 10th highest historical greenhouse gas emissions, Canada has the responsibility to alleviate the climate crisis - not make it worse.

► Pumping every last drop of oil and fracking every last molecule of gas won't lower the high costs of living in Canada. It will only line the pockets of the world's biggest oil and gas corporations, while burdening taxpayers in Canada with the high costs of climate chaos and worsening health outcomes.

► When your government passed Bill C-5, the so-called "One Canadian Economy Act," it undermined the government of Canada's already minimal commitments to the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP), lowering emissions, enforcing environmental protections, and declaring a national climate emergency.
